LINK CHOICE



The Program

The Link Choice program is a “members only” health services discount program offered by the local provider community to employers and individuals. **It is not an insurance program.** The program is comprised of a schedule of highly discounted services that are provided to members through participating providers. The program provides for hospital, physician, pharmaceutical, and other services. **The range of services offered is limited to those that are medically necessary and that can be provided by those providers of healthcare services that participate in the program.**

The goal of the program is to make healthcare services accessible to those who do not currently enjoy access to health services through an insured health plan. This program is subsidized through the providers that participate in the program and may never be used as a replacement for existing commercially available or subsidized (CHIP, adultBasic, Medicare, etc.) health insurance.

A monthly access fee is paid per member enrolled in the program. When the member uses the program, a discount will be given by the provider. A complete discount schedule is provided as an addition to this Guide.

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Eligibility

Employers and individuals must meet eligibility guidelines to participate in the program. The following are basic eligibility guidelines. **These may be modified at any time, at the discretion of the Link Choice program.**

When applying for the program, our staff will evaluate the purchaser for eligibility. Our goal is to keep the process simple and straightforward; however, we may request that purchasers provide evidence that they are in compliance with the program’s eligibility requirements. It is at our sole discretion to accept or reject employers or individuals for this program based on our assessment of their compliance with our eligibility requirements.

INDIVIDUAL ELIGIBILITY

- e All members must be under age 65.
- e The individual must have an annual income less than \$30,000. Individuals with income greater than \$30,000 may be eligible, but must meet an individual income guideline of 350% of Federal Poverty Level.
- e The individual must not qualify for or participate in any other health plans or related programs, such as; CHIP, adultBasic, Medical Assistance, Medicare, etc.

EMPLOYER ELIGIBILITY

- e The business must be located in Tioga County or surrounding counties.
- e The business must not have provided health insurance in the past 3 months.

Important Restrictions

- e Link Choice is never to be used as a replacement for or in addition to a commercial insured health insurance plan.
- e Link Choice and the providers participating in the program reserve the right at any time to remove an individual from the program or to decline to provide the discounts available under the program to any member if in our sole judgment this has occurred.
- e Link Choice cannot be used by an individual who is eligible for or participates in other health coverage, such as, CHIP, adultBasic, Medicare, Medical Assistance, etc.
- e The participant must remain compliant with the program's eligibility requirements at all times. Please contact our staff for current guidelines.
- e Soldiers + Sailors Memorial Hospital is an approved and participating provider for the Link Choice Program; however, we cannot guarantee that all physicians that provide service at the hospital facility participate in this program. The reason is that some providers who practice at the hospital do so as independent providers and may choose not to participate in this program. Under these circumstances parts of your care may not be covered under this plan. Members are advised to confirm participation of all providers of care prior to hospital procedures.

Member Status

In order to obtain the benefits described here, you must remain compliant and in good standing with the Link Choice program. Your member status and current program materials can be obtained through our web site at:

Your profile is accessed using the identification number provided on your Link Choice identification card.

Access Fees

An access fee, per person enrolled in the program will be paid by the member or the employer. Failure to remain current with access fees will cause the member to lose program access.

Services Provided

The program provides for physician, hospital, pharmaceutical, and other services, such as, laboratory, rehabilitation, home health and nursing home care. The range of services offered is limited to medically necessary services that can be provided by *participating physicians* and those services available at *Soldiers + Sailors Memorial Hospital* in Wellsboro. Services that are preventative in nature are discounted even more highly than others to encourage good health.

How Benefits Are Provided

Clinical Services

- e An identification card is provided to all members. The identification card must be presented to the provider prior to receiving services.
- e **Remember, not all providers participate in the Link program.** The member should verify provider participation before receiving services. To find a participating provider you can call Link Healthcare at 570.723.0710 or refer to your Link Choice User Guide.
- e Services are provided, as needed.
- e **FOR SERVICES PROVIDED AT SOLDIERS + SAILORS MEMORIAL HOSPITAL,** Link members must report to the Patient Representative before reporting to Registration.
- e For **hospital outpatient services** (outpatient surgery or testing such as laboratory, x-ray, cardiopulmonary etc.) at Soldiers + Sailors Memorial Hospital the Link member may call a patient representative at 800.877.2455 or 570.724.1750 (local). The Patient Representative will assist the member with pricing estimates and questions. It is essential that the member pay at the time of service or set-up a payment arrangement within 10 days. Failure to abide by the payment arrangement will void all discounts and result in a non-discounted bill for services. If additional services are ordered during the member visit (generally x-ray and cardiopulmonary services) the member will be assisted in the process by the department and directed back to the Patient Representative to make payment arrangements.
- e For **hospital inpatient services** provided at Soldiers + Sailors Memorial Hospital the member is responsible for a deposit (as specified in the Discount Schedule Guide) for all medically necessary non-emergency inpatient stays. Upon discharge, the member will meet with the hospital cashier and pay a deposit. A full bill will be generated and sent to the member. Upon receipt of the bill, the member will have 10 days to contact the Hospital billing staff to receive your discount on the billed amount. At that time the member must either make payment in full of the discounted amount or make arrangements for a payment plan. Failure to pay deposit or any subsequent scheduled payments will result in the loss of benefit and a full, non-discounted bill for services to the member.
- e For **emergency services** provided at Soldiers + Sailors Memorial Hospital, a deposit (see schedule) is required at the time of service. The balance for the service will be billed at non-discount rates. Upon receipt of the bill, the member will have 10 days to present the bill and the Link Choice identification card to the hospital cashier for payment. Bills paid at this time will be discounted as specified in the schedule of discounts.
- e For **physician office services**, the member will generally not be able to anticipate the cost of the visit because the service will not be known in advance. The member should generally be prepared to pay for a Level 3 visit (refer to discount schedule). At the conclusion of the visit, if the amount is greater than this, the member will pay for the level 3 office visit and then receive a bill for a balance due. The member will have five days to make payment to the provider for the balance. Payments made within the five days will be subject to the discount per the discount guide. Payments after five days will not be eligible for discount and will be billed in full.



Pharmaceutical Services

- e The pharmacy component of the Link Choice program provides a discount card through Express Scripts that may be used at participating pharmacies. Express Scripts is one of the nation's largest independent pharmacy benefit management companies. The Express Scripts program is not an insurance product.
- e The Express Scripts card is convenient and easy to use. You can fill your prescriptions and save two different ways:
 - **At your local participating pharmacy** - Use a retail pharmacy for prescriptions you need filled immediately or are one-time prescriptions with no refills. The Express Scripts card is honored at over 56,000 pharmacies located nationwide.
 - **Through Express Scripts mail service pharmacy** - Use mail service for drugs you take on a long-term basis. You should ask your physician to write a prescription for a 90 day supply, plus appropriate refills for up to one year. Then all you do is mail your prescription along with payment and a completed mail order form. Your order will be delivered free of shipping costs within two weeks. You will be charged for overnight or second-day delivery, when you request such service. Refills can be ordered by phone, mail or on-line.



Provider Participation

Participation is open to any local provider willing to accept the established discounted rates as payment in full for services rendered. Providers participate in this program as a community service to persons in this community. This is not a government sponsored program. Providers receive no reimbursement beyond what they are paid at the time of service and they are not required to participate.



A listing of healthcare providers that have already agreed to participate in the program is provided below. However, the program is not restricted to these providers. Any provider of healthcare services has the ability to provide members with these services under these terms at any time on a voluntary basis. You may present the schedule of discounts to any provider and ask if that provider will accept the discount payment.

Soldiers + Sailors Memorial Hospital is a non-profit community hospital serving all of Tioga County. SSMH supports approximately 50 physicians representing a broad range of specialties. SSMH, in combination with its physicians, offers primary general hospital care and a broad range of support services. These include laboratory, radiology, rehabilitation, pharmacy, surgical, behavioral, obstetrics, and occupational services, to name a few.

Cardiopulmonary Services (Respiratory Therapy, Cardiology and Electroencephalogram)

Cardiopulmonary Therapy Services provide a variety of tests for diagnosing and evaluating how effectively a patient's respiratory and/or cardiac systems functions, including pulmonary function testing, lung diffusion testing, blood gas analysis, cardiac stress testing, echocardiograms, and EKGs. Outpatient cardiac event monitors are available for patients to wear up to 30 days and are used to help physicians diagnose arrhythmia problems. Holter monitors are also available and record 24 hours of the patient's heart activity. All services require a physician's order.

EEG(electroencephalogram) testing is also available in Cardiopulmonary Services. This is a neurological study of brain wave activity.

Cardiopulmonary Therapy Services also offers sleep studies, which may help your physician diagnose a variety of sleep disorders, including: sleep apnea, periodic cessation (stops) of breathing while asleep; chronic insomnia; and narcolepsy, a neurological disorder characterized by sudden, uncontrollable sleep attacks and persistent daytime sleepiness. All sleep studies are done on an outpatient basis and must be scheduled in advance. Once testing is completed, results are available in only 48 hours.

Speech Therapy

They work in the school districts helping children with learning disabilities, as well as in the outpatient setting working to improve patients' speech and language skills.
